An education system that stands out

The quality of teaching and the dynamic nature of research in Québec are recognized worldwide. Our educational institutions also collaborate with a number of prestigious international partners.

The college sector is one of the distinctive features of the higher education system in Québec. The college network consists of CEGEPs (general and vocational colleges), government schools, institutes and private colleges. In addition to pre-university training, which lasts two years, the network offers a variety of technical training programs that give direct access to the job market.

In Québec, higher education is valued, and student perseverance is supported. The success of our students also depends on a hands-on approach, such as internships with companies, and on the availability of the teaching staff. This proximity to the teachers and professors makes us stand out and creates a climate of trust that is conducive to academic success.

The importance given to research, innovation and technology transfer

Our institutions of higher education possess valuable resources dedicated to the development and acquisition of key competencies in research and innovation to meet the current challenges of society. In addition, several initiatives are deployed to support the transfer and promotion of research outcomes. Educational institutions also collaborate with recognized technology parks and prestigious research centres in cutting-edge industries.

For example, a network of college centres for the transfer of technologies makes it possible to create and nurture collaboration between educational institutions, companies and organizations

in their communities. This initiative also enables numerous internships and job opportunities to be offered to students.

Tuition fees for graduate and postgraduate studies, with a focus on research, are very competitive internationally. Some merit scholarships are also available to support the education of international students, who can work as professionals and research assistants in universities in Québec while pursuing their studies.

Plan your stay in Québec in only four steps

Choose your program and institution

Explore programs of study by visiting the websites of colleges and universities.

The website of the Québec government can also help you.



Submit your application for admission

Each program has admission requirements, dates and deadlines to be met when you

apply. To know what they are, contact the institution that offers the program you have selected.



Obtain a Québec Acceptance Certificate for studies

When you receive your letter of admission to a program of study, promptly apply to the MIFI for a

Québec Acceptance Certificate for studies by consulting: **Québec.ca/en/immigration**

Obtain a permit to study in Canada

A study permit from the Canadian government is compulsory if you are on a program of study that lasts six months or more. You can apply

for a permit from Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada (IRCC): **canada.ca/en/services/immigration-citizenship**

Ensure that you have the necessary financial resources

Yes, the cost of living and education in Québec is among the lowest in North America. However, in order to study here, you must still prove that you have sufficient financial resources to cover the following expenses:

- Tuition fees
- Other costs related to your enrolment: related expenses, costs of teaching materials, student association fees, health and hospitalization insurance premiums
- Travel costs (round trip) from your country of origin
- Costs of settling in when you arrive
- Living expenses for the duration of your stay
- You must also be able to cover the costs of examinations related to an application for a Québec Acceptance Certificate and a study permit.
